### **CAMP BENCHMARK at MILLCREEK Elementary**

This is a summer remediation program, designed for Central Bucks students who have not attained the established Central Bucks Proficiency Benchmarks and Academic Standards. If you are unsure as to whether your student would benefit from this program, please discuss with your child's teacher. Out of district students may enroll depending upon availability.

#### **COURSES:**

These courses are appropriate for students completing grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 and needing additional assistance to meet the established Central Bucks Proficiency Benchmarks.

#### **READING**

Grades K-2 Use of word recognition techniques and phonics to develop stronger reading strategies to become more independent readers.

Grades 3/4 -Use of word recognition techniques to develop stronger reading strategies to become more fluent and independent readers.

Grades 5/6-Strengthening reading strategies, by concentrating on vocabulary development and comprehension activities to become more independent readers.

#### **MATH**

Grades K-2 Reinforce basic math skills,

Grades 3/4-Reinforce basic math skills, further understanding basic math concepts, develop problem-solving strategies, and write about mathematical thinking.

Grades 5/6-Develop a deeper conceptual understanding of math by using their basic math skills in problem-solving activities and writing about mathematical thinking.

#### **WRITING**

Grades 3/4- Strengthen writing skills, including choosing appropriate topics, developing ideas and writing to the interest of an audience. Grammar and mechanics reinforced.

Grades 5/6- Strengthen writing skills by employing strategies to become a more sophisticated writer. Continue to develop topics and ideas. Work on constructing pieces of writing that are longer and more complex.
